Our 61st year as a charity brings new beginnings and will allow us to have a much wider reach and help many more vulnerable cats. This will be the first time we've been able to run our own cattery, and we are very excited at the prospect. We hope to welcome rescue cats to our modern facility in March 2026.

This comes at a huge cost, and we've been so grateful to have inherited a large donation to enable us to fund the build. We are a separate charity independent from the National RSPCA and we raise our own funds and make our own decisions. **NEXT STEP** is to raise £75,000 to contribute towards the total cost of £220,000. 
A message from our Kendal charity shop


