Since I arrived in 2017 the Branch has grown from a small office and shop on Highgate to offices and a Hall on Beezon Fields from where we could run our rehoming operations. The next exciting stage is we are hoping to build our own cattery unit opposite our offices. That will increase capacity from 6 pens to 20 pens. From there we can help the Inspectors rehome many more rescued cats and kittens. Once we have that up and running we will look to reinstate dog rehoming again.






Handsome boy, Tigger has settled perfectly into his new home!

Trap Neuter Release Scheme — TNR

Here at RSPCA Westmorland, we offer a **Trap, Neuter, Release Scheme** for feral cats within the community. Over this last year we have done 35 TNRs.

We have been currently working with Shap Wells hotel and have completed 14 TNRs. Additionally, we have completed 8 at Shap as well as Liquorice and her 3 kittens.

Burton Services asked us to help with a feral mum and her 4 kittens. Mum was neutered and released with all her kittens in foster care.

It costs us £154 per feral cat This includes:

- Blood test
- Chip
- Flea and worming
- Neutering

We are always grateful for a small donation to help cover our costs.
